FOOD SERVICES

SALE OF NON-NUTRITIONAL FOODS

Date: November 1, 1994

Pickens County Board of Education restricts the sale of food of minimal nutritional value for elementary schools or below from the beginning of the school day through the end of the last meal period. The school day begins at 12:01 a.m.

Pickens County Board of Education restricts the sale of food of minimal nutritional value for schools above elementary level during the meal periods in the food service areas.

Elementary schools are defined as schools that house grades K-5, Middle grades as 6-8 and high school as 9-12.

Foods of minimal nutritional value are defined by federal regulations to include carbonated beverages, chewing gum, water ices and certain candies. Candies are defined by federal regulations to include jellies, marshmallow candies and candy coated popcorn.

Meal periods include breakfast and/or lunch periods.
